The WCC will be held in Vancouver, Canada and will be jointly organized and run by Vancouver and Burnaby Football Clubs. The event will be held on July 22nd and 23rd and will be involving some of the best teams from Western North America.

Games will be played at University of British Columbia (UBC), which includes games being held at the famous Thunderbird Stadium, which is one of the best Australian Football fields in North America. UBC is only ten minutes from downtown Vancouver, and accommodation is available on site close to the field. The rooms are dorm style and accommodation is approximately USD \$33.00 per night per person including breakfast. Games will be held over Saturday 22nd July and Sunday 23rd of July with each team playing at least three games. Rules will be governed by US Footy and teams will be made up of 50% Australian and 50% "Non-Australian".
